ADJUDICATORS

BRASS

Thomas Ashworth (Senior, Young Artist Brass), is professor of trombone at the University Minnesota-Twin Cities. Many of his former students are enjoying careers as public school and university educators, orchestral and military ensemble musicians and as freelance performers and teachers. Ashworth has performed, toured and recorded with the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra.

Lynn Erickson (Senior, Young Artist Brass), has played trumpet for the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra since 1991. She received both master of fine arts and doctor of musical arts degrees from the University of Minnesota, and studied with Charles Schlueter, David Baldwin, Vincent Cichowicz and Manny Laureano. She teaches at Augsburg University and Macalester College.

James Ferree (Senior, Young Artist Brass), an Atlanta native, joined the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra as principal horn in 2018. Ferree was previously a member of the Richmond Symphony, Verbier Chamber Orchestra and New World Symphony. Holding degrees from the Juilliard School, James's teachers include William Purvis, Jerome Ashby, Richard Deane and Hermann Baumann.

PIANO

Alexander Braginsky (Junior Piano) DMA, NCTM, is professor of piano at the University of Minnesota and frequently judges international and national piano competitions. He's founder and president of the International Piano e-Competition. His students are frequent winners of national and international competitions, including MTNA. Braginsky's teachers were Theodore Gutman and Alexander Goldenweiser at the Tchaikovsky Conservatory.

Alan Huckleberry (Senior, Young Artist Piano), is recognized as a multi-faceted artist, has performed across the globe and recorded 13 CDs. Additionally, Huckleberry is equally passionate about his role as an educator. At the University of Iowa, he heads the piano pedagogy program, now recognized as one of the leading programs in the nation.

Ivan Konev (Junior, Senior, Young Artist Piano) completed his bachelor's and master's degrees from the Music College at the Moscow Conservatory and Gnessin's Academy. He holds a DMA in piano performance from the University of Minnesota. Konev is a piano faculty member at University of Wisconsin-River Falls where he heads UWRF Piano Festival & Competition.

Stella Sick (Junior, Senior Young Artist Piano) holds degrees from the Eastman School of Music and the University of Minnesota. A pioneer in the field of long-distance instruction, she has been a managing director of the International Piano-e-Competition in Minnesota since 2004. Stella is an adjunct assistant instructor at Hamline University.

SENIOR PIANO DUET

Irina Elkina, internationally known for her piano duo performances with her sister Julia, has performed at venues from the Ordway Center in St. Paul to the Lincoln Center in New York. Irina graduated from the St. Petersburg Conservatory (Russia) and holds a doctoral degree from the University of Minnesota. She teaches at the MacPhail Center for Music.

Amy Hamann, alongside her sister, Sara, has captivated audiences and critics alike, having won numerous first prizes internationally and been a featured artist with the Minnesota Orchestra, Chautauqua Symphony Orchestra, Columbus Symphony Orchestra, Dame Myra Hess Memorial Concert Series, Oslo International Music Festival and the Quebec International Duo-Piano Festival.

Rebecca Payne Shockley is professor emerita of piano pedagogy at the University of Minnesota. She has given presentations on music learning in the U.S. and abroad. She is the author of *Mapping Music* and a revised edition of her mother's memoirs, *Is There a Piano in the House?*

STRING

Charles Gray (Senior, Young Artist String), is professor of violin and viola at St. Olaf College. Winner of the Fischhoff and Cleveland Quartet Competitions, a 20-plus year performer with the Minnesota Orchestra, and ASTA String Teacher of the Year in Minnesota, he attended the University of Michigan and the Eastman School of Music.

Natalia Moiseeva (Junior, Senior, Young Artist String), violin, holds BM and MM degrees from the Moscow State Tchaikovsky Conservatory and a DMA degree from the University of Minnesota. She is an assistant concertmaster of the Minnesota Opera Orchestra and is on the faculty at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls, Carleton and Gustavus Adolphus Colleges.

Sally O'Reilly (Junior String), professor of violin at the University of Minnesota School of Music in Minneapolis, and is the artistic director of the Pienza Music Festival in Italy. Her technical works for strings are published by Kjos Music Company. Former students are soloists and members of many of the world's greatest orchestras and faculties.

Thomas Rosenberg (Junior, Senior, Young Artist String), cello, is a nationally known performer, teacher and chamber music coach. He has been artistic director of the Fischhoff National Chamber Music Competition since 1981 and is the director of the St. Paul Summer Chamber Music Institute. He teaches at Carleton and Macalester Colleges.

VOICE

Stanford Felix (Senior, Young Artist Voice), a lecturer on the voice faculty at the University of Minnesota, has performed extensively as a bass-baritone on the operatic and concert stages. He holds DMA and BFA degrees in voice performance from University of Kansas and an MM degree in voice performance from the Manhattan School of Music.

Rick Penning (Senior, Young Artist Voice), baritone, holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Minnesota, a Master of Music degree from the University of Cincinnati and a Bachelor of Arts degree from Luther College. He maintains voice studios at Carleton College, where he is voice studies program coordinator and at Augsburg University.

Emery Stephens (Senior, Young Artist Voice), baritone, is an assistant professor at St. Olaf College. He is a teaching artist for the Song of America project and a contributing author of *So You Want to Sing Spirituals* by Randy Jones. He earned degrees from Gordon College, Boston University and the University of Michigan.

WOODWIND

Scott Anderson (Young Artist Woodwind), was principal clarinetist of the Honolulu Symphony, Grand Rapids Symphony, and other ensembles. He was also a member of the Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra and active as a recording studio musician. He taught previously at the University of California Berkeley and at Interlochen Fine Arts Camp.

Immanuel Davis (Junior, Senior Woodwind), performs internationally on both baroque and modern flutes. Davis is one of the most versatile flutists of his generation. His latest recordings are, *La Magnifique: Flute Music for the Court of Louis XIV* and *Nikolai Kapustin: Complete Chamber Works for Flute*. He studied at Juilliard with Julius Baker.

Preston Duncan (Senior, Young Artist Woodwind), teaches at the world-renowned saxophone studio at the University of Minnesota School of Music. A Fulbright Scholar, he is an internationally prominent performer and educator with appearances throughout the U.S., Europe, Latin American and Asia. His former teachers include Eugene Rousseau, John Sampen and Kenneth Radnofsky.

Jennifer Gerth (Senior Woodwind), clarinet, is in her 25th season as principal clarinet of the Duluth-Superior Symphony Orchestra.
